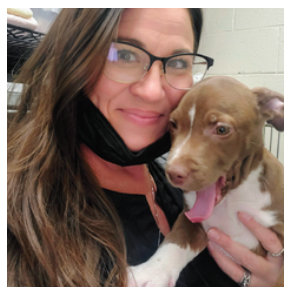

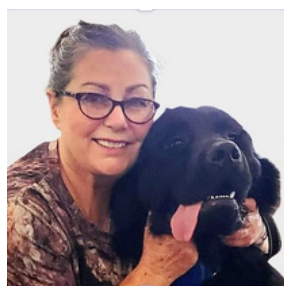
MEET OUR RESCUE COORDINATORS

Now you can take advantage of these special benefits. Benefits are available immediately once your packet is approved, but we do have a 90-Day New Rescue period where all services rendered must be paid for in full during the first 90-Days of working together.

Discounted Care

- You now receive significantly discounted exam fees at 30% off.
- 25% off the remainder of the bill (some items and services are not discountable)
- Exam discounts do not apply to specialty care; however, you will still receive your rescue discount.

Coupon Program

- Once a voucher is turned in and we gain a client, we will apply a credit to your account, in addition to the adopter receiving credit off his/her bill! Please let me know if you would like to participate.

Spay & Neuter Program

- We offer our rescues discounted Spay and Neuter pricing, OVHs at \$290 and Neuters at \$265. For your adopted pets, we charge the rescue \$120 OVH, \$95 Neuter (billed monthly), and the new adopter is charged a \$170 (\$200 if a patient is over 1 year old or 65lbs). These prices include mandatory pre-op blood work*, pain medications, and an e-collar that the patient goes home with.
 - Pre-op bloodwork is required for all surgical procedures
 - These are bundled prices and can not be broken up

TNR's

- TNR pricing is \$96 for male cats and \$137 for female cats. Includes ear tip, FVRCP, Rabies vaccine. Be aware this are subject to availability.

Heartworm Treatments - Bundle

- Bundle includes 3 days of hospitalization, Prednisone, Doxycycline, Melarsomine, Gabapentin, Trazodone, and microfilaria testing on day 120.
- Dogs <45 lbs - \$632.50
- 46lbs and over - \$776.50
